WHAT SHOULD I WEAR?

- Dress for the weather – you may be inside or outside.
- Shoes or boots with a small heel are appropriate footwear.
- You must wear an ASTM/SEI certified equestrian helmet. You may borrow one of ours for this introductory session.

WHO ARE THE INSTRUCTORS?

All instructors at Ironstone Farm are licensed by the Massachusetts Department of Agriculture and receive additional training at Ironstone.

WHAT IS THE REGISTRATION PROCEDURE?

In addition, if a participant has a diagnosis or disability, or needs medication, a Physician's Approval form is required. Call the office for more information (978-475-4056). It is imperative that we have this information no later than Wednesday, March 4 at 1 p.m.

WHY DO YOU NEED TO KNOW MY HEIGHT AND WEIGHT?

All of our horses have weight restrictions. To best match you with a horse, we need to have this information ahead of time.

WHAT IF I AM INTERESTED IN ADDITIONAL RIDING LESSONS?

Staff will be on hand to provide information to you and answer your questions.

MAY I BRING A TREAT FOR MY HORSE?

We are sorry but for safety reasons we do not hand feed our horses. We will happily take apples and carrots and place these items in their feed buckets.

MAY I TAKE PICTURES?

Absolutely! Please limit your pictures to your family and the horses (not other participants).

WHAT IF I NEED TO CANCEL?
